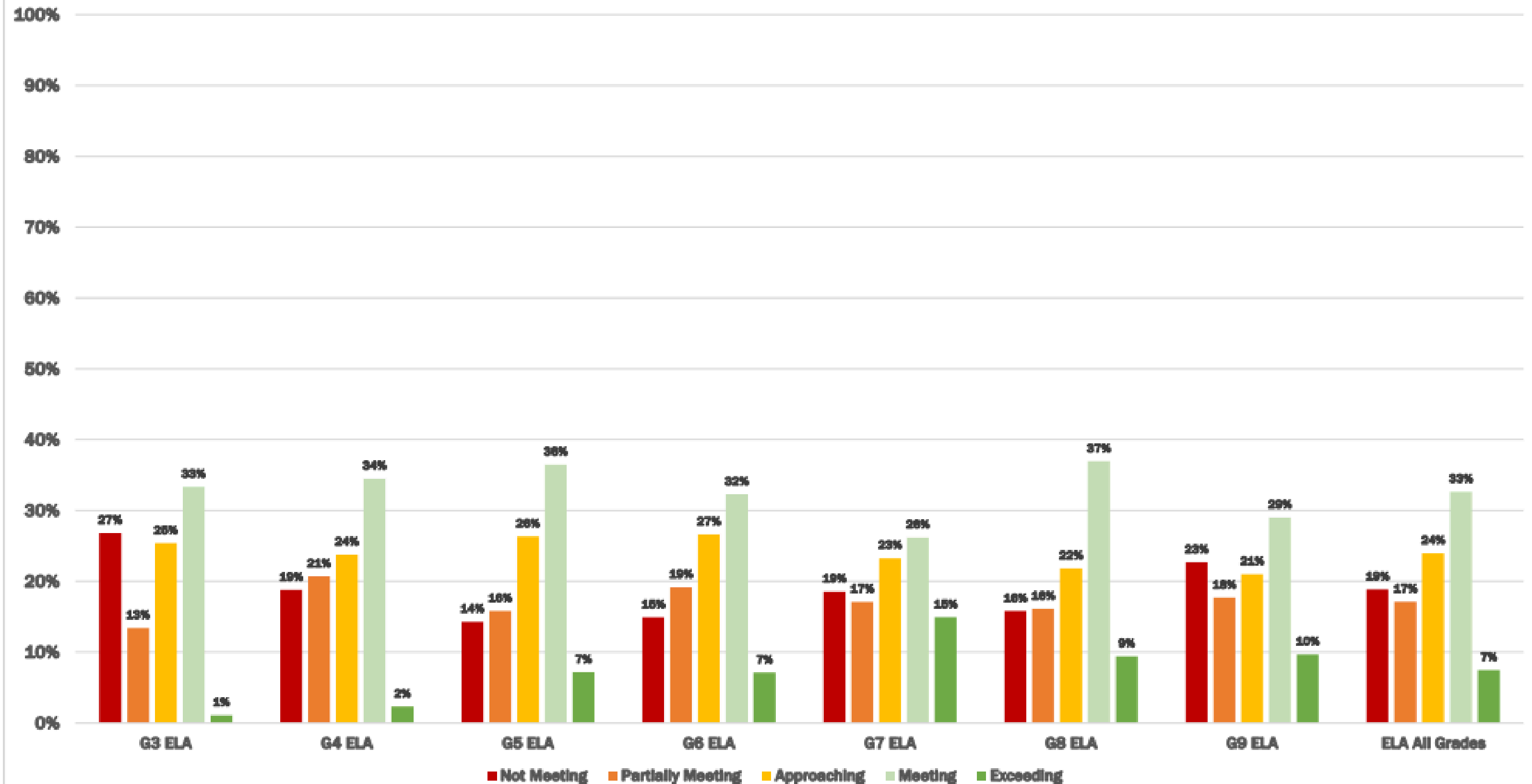

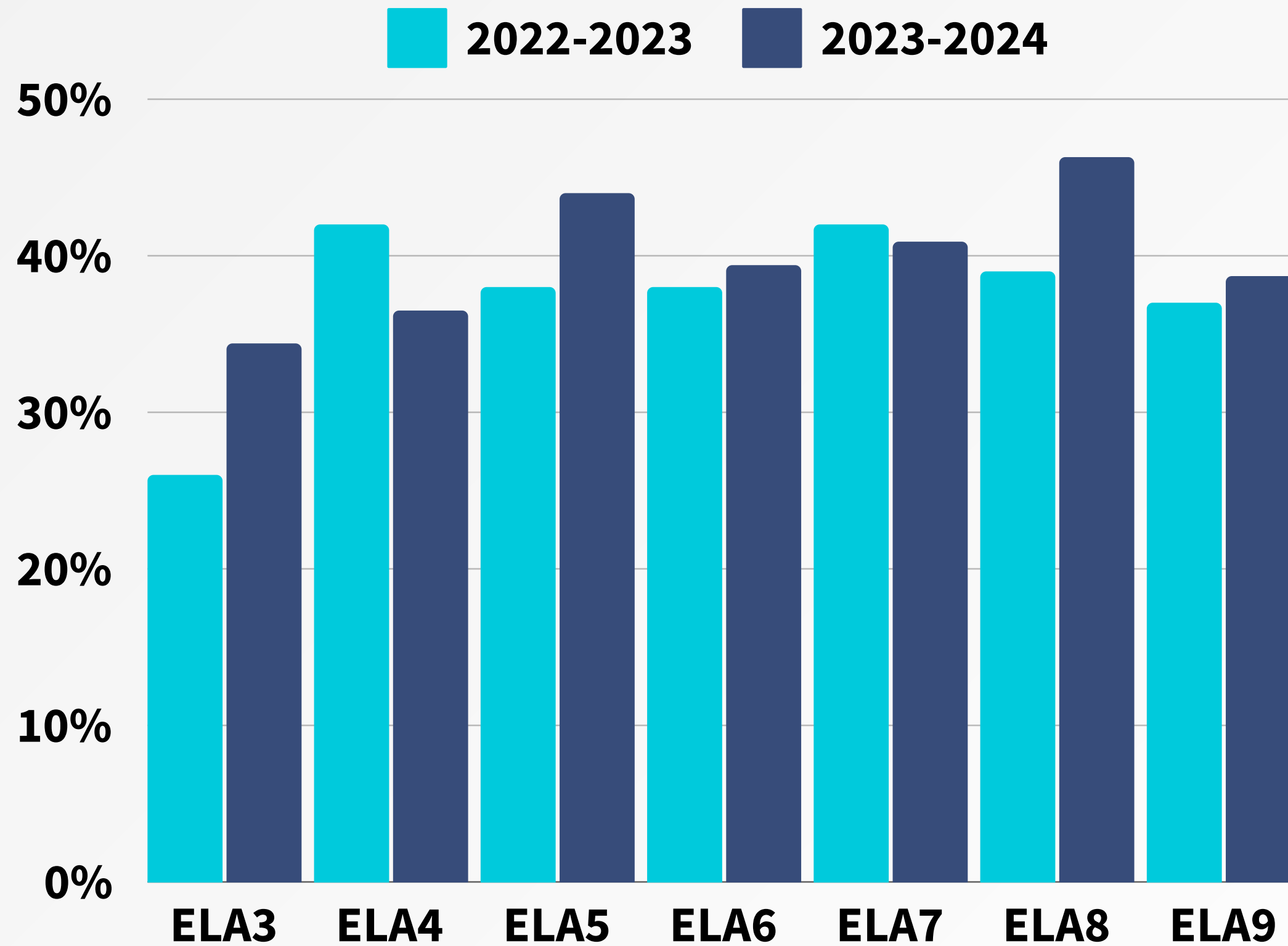

Distribution by Achievement Level (2023-24)

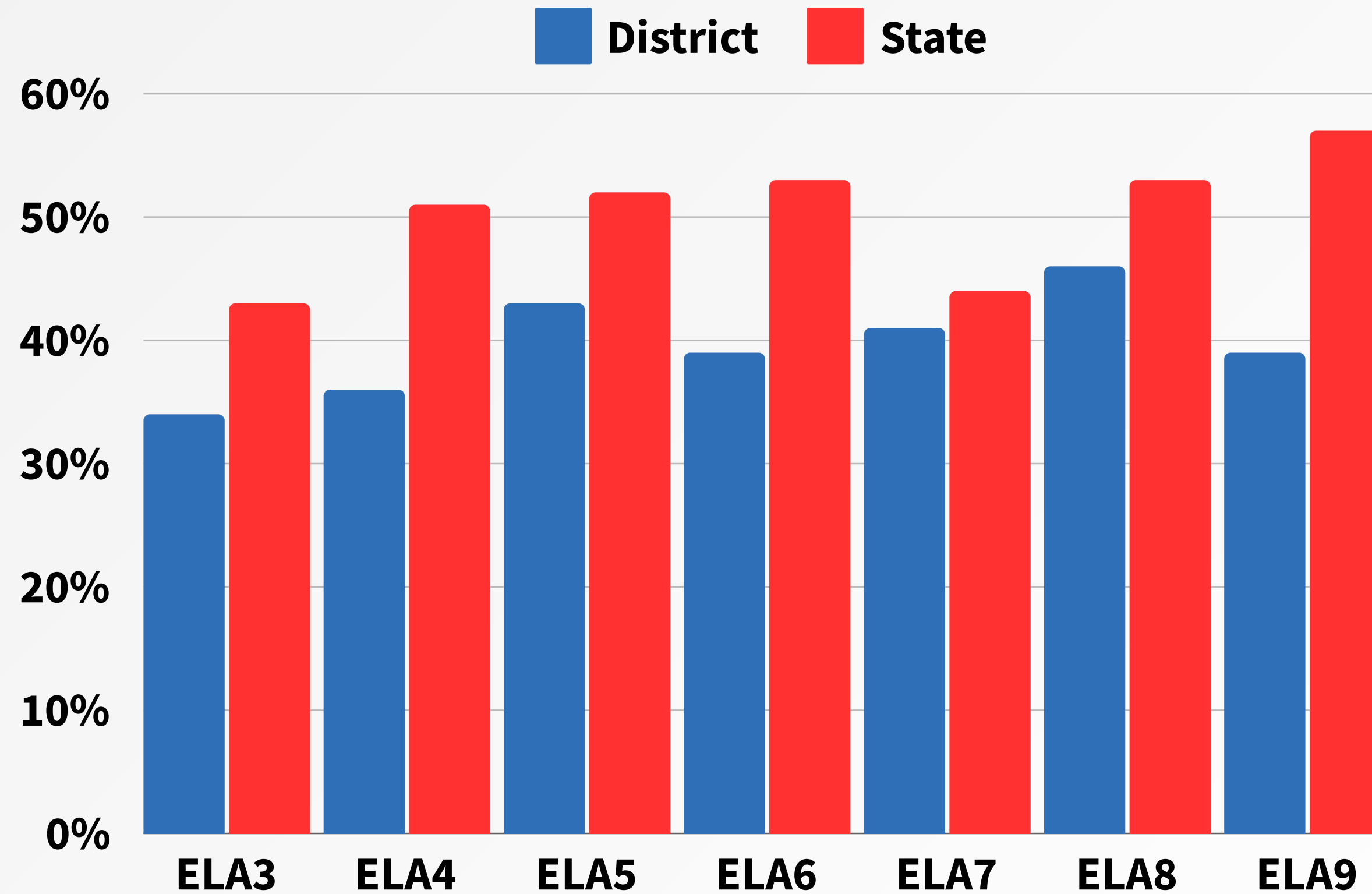


# 2022-2023 and 2023-2024 ELA Passing Comparison

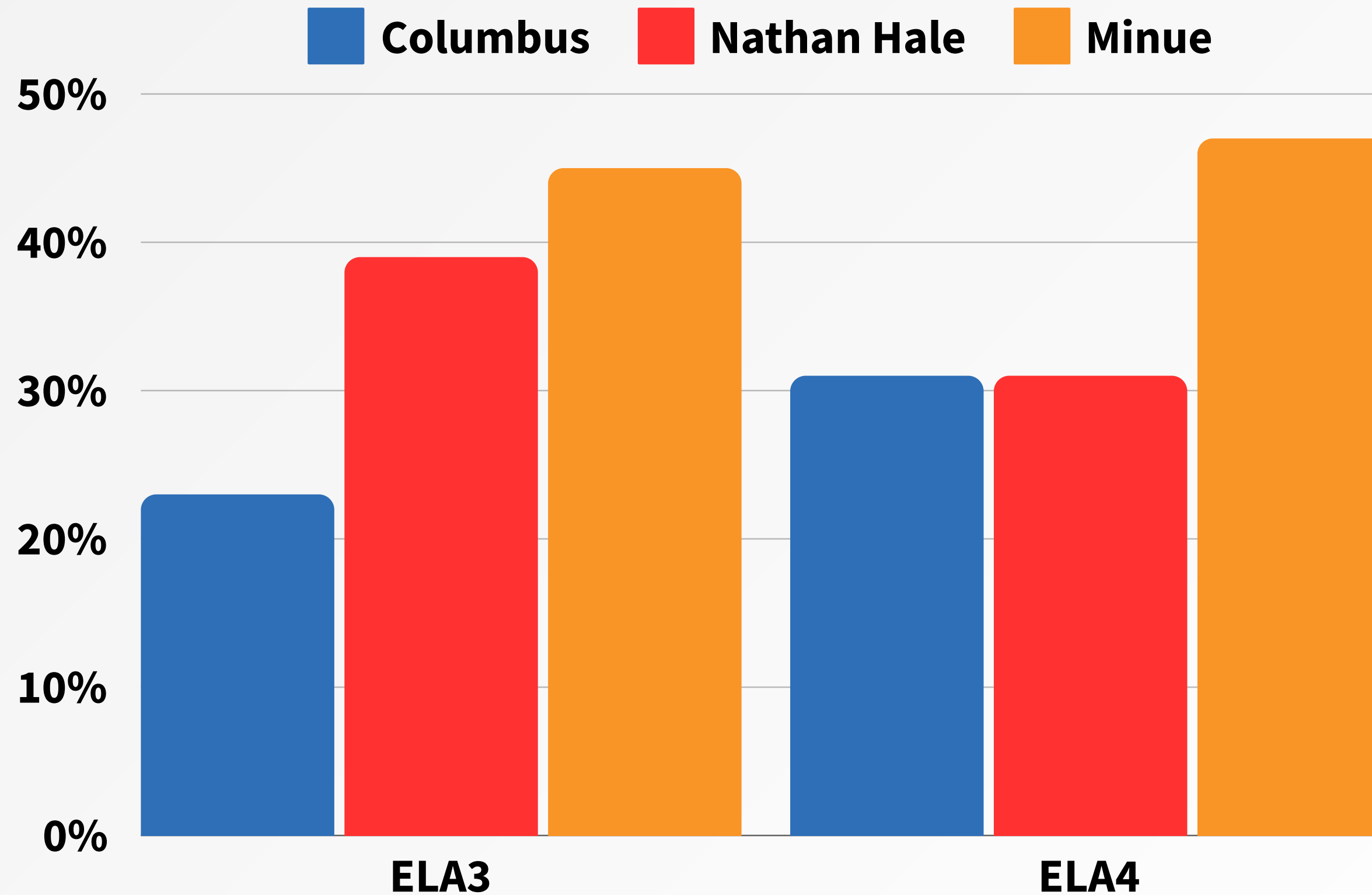




# 2023-2024 State & District ELA Passing Comparison

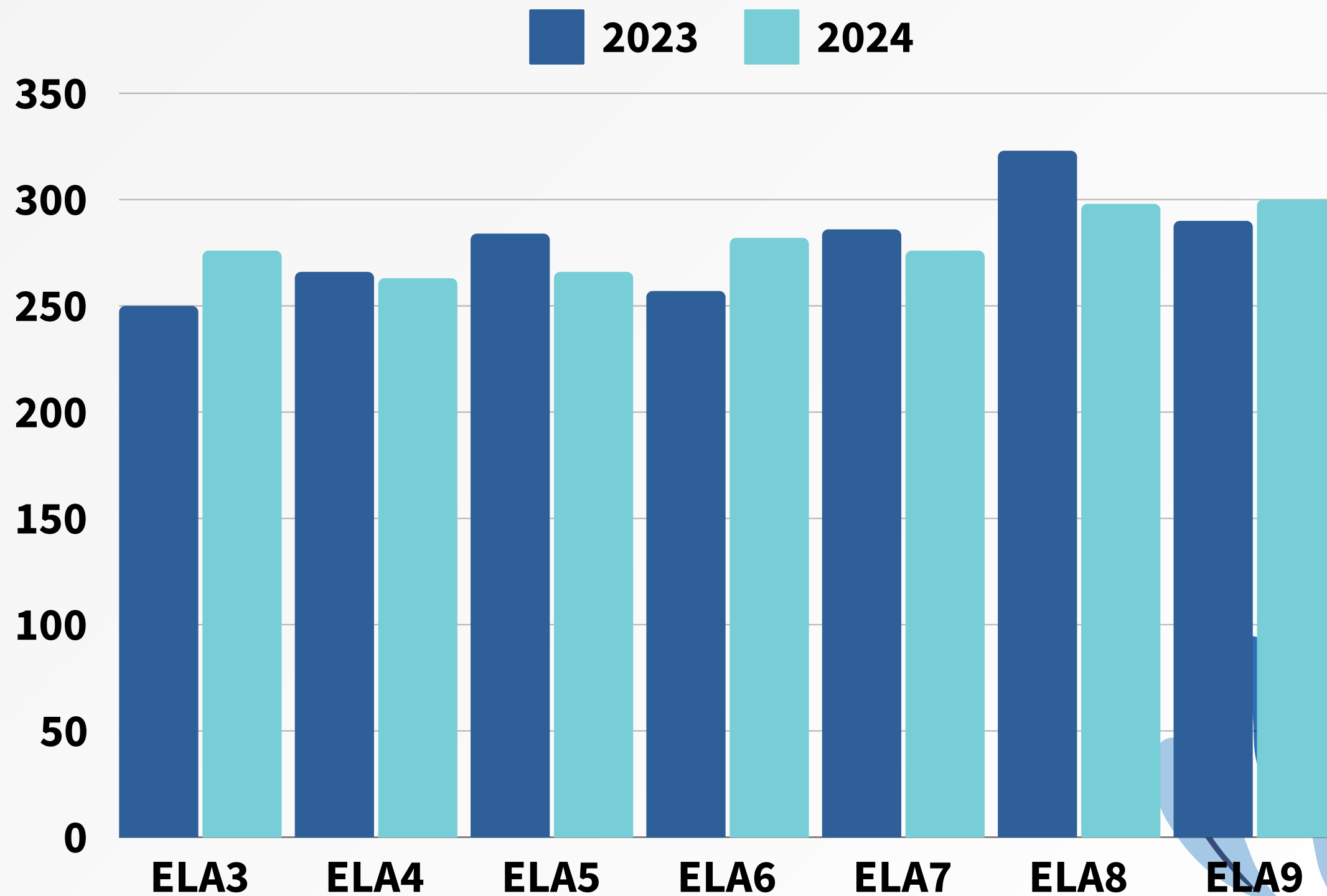

Algebra 1, 2 and Geometry data: Students in grades 11 and 12 were not included

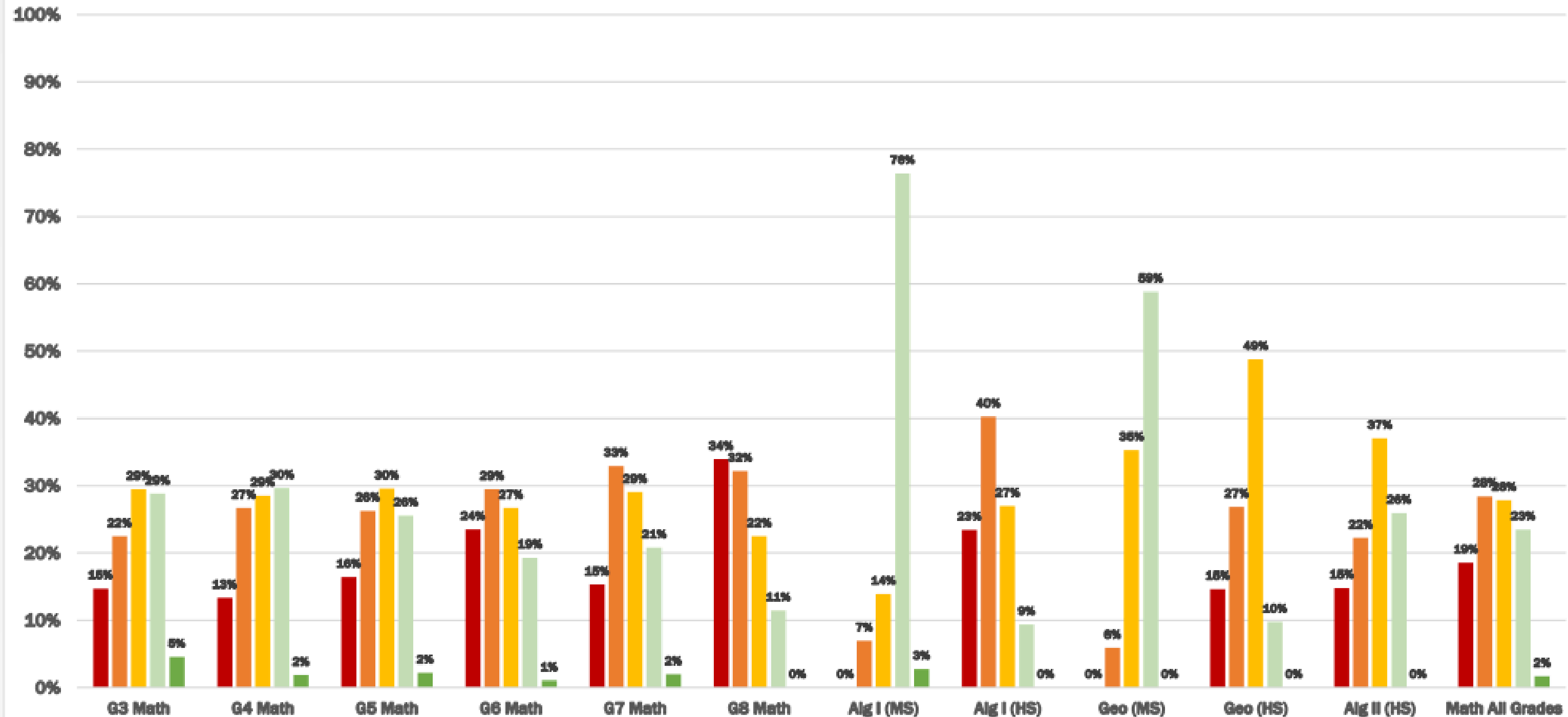

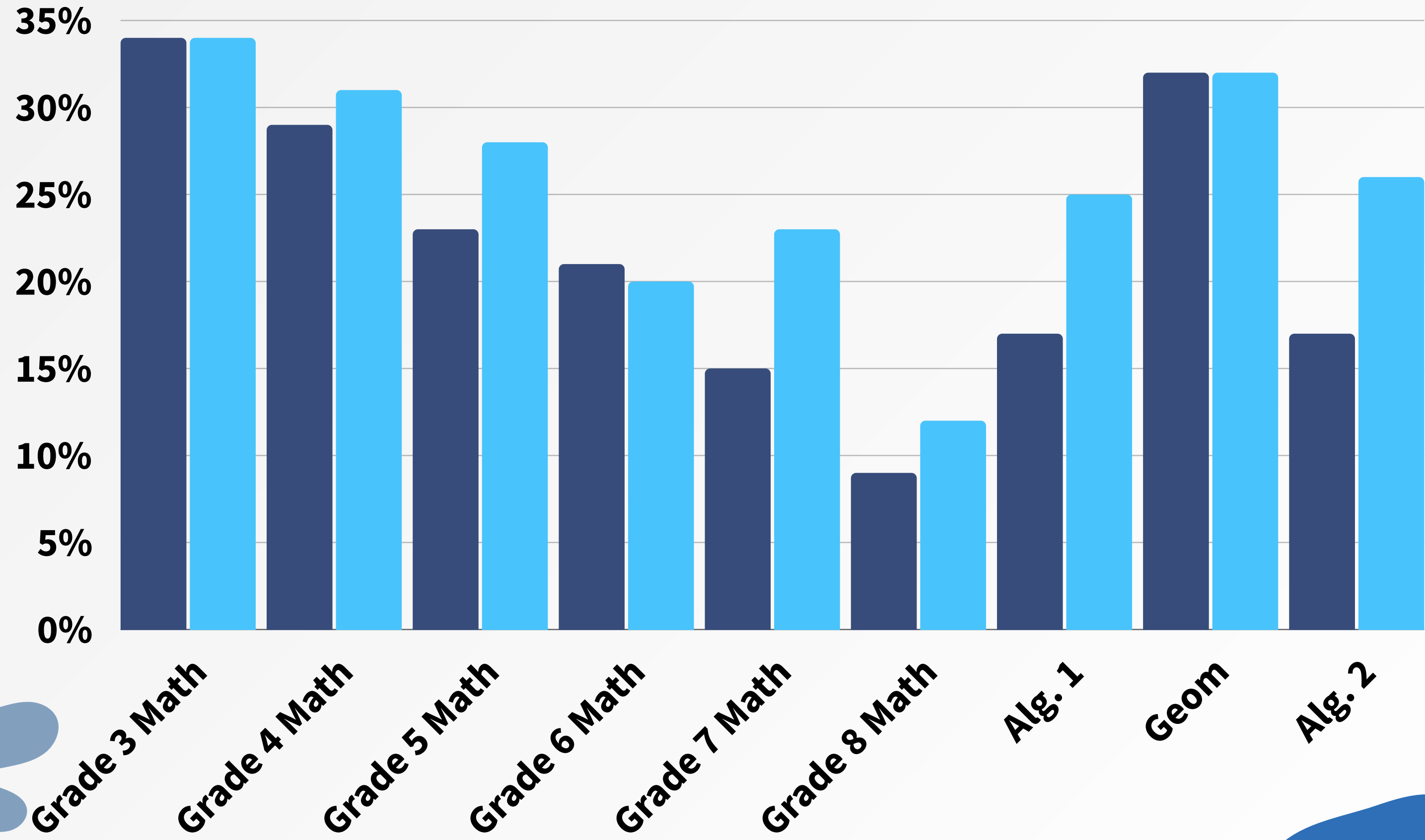

# 2022-2023 and 2023-2024 Math Passing Comparison

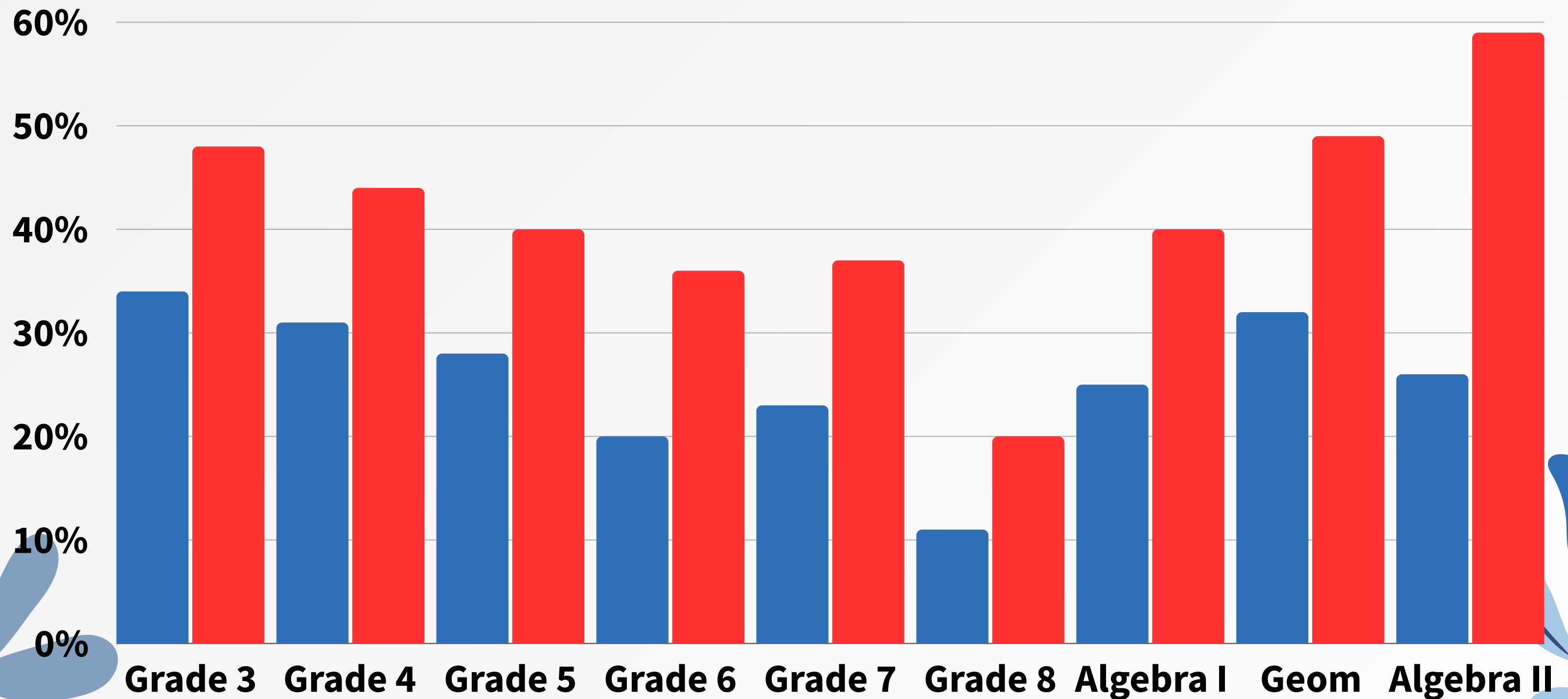

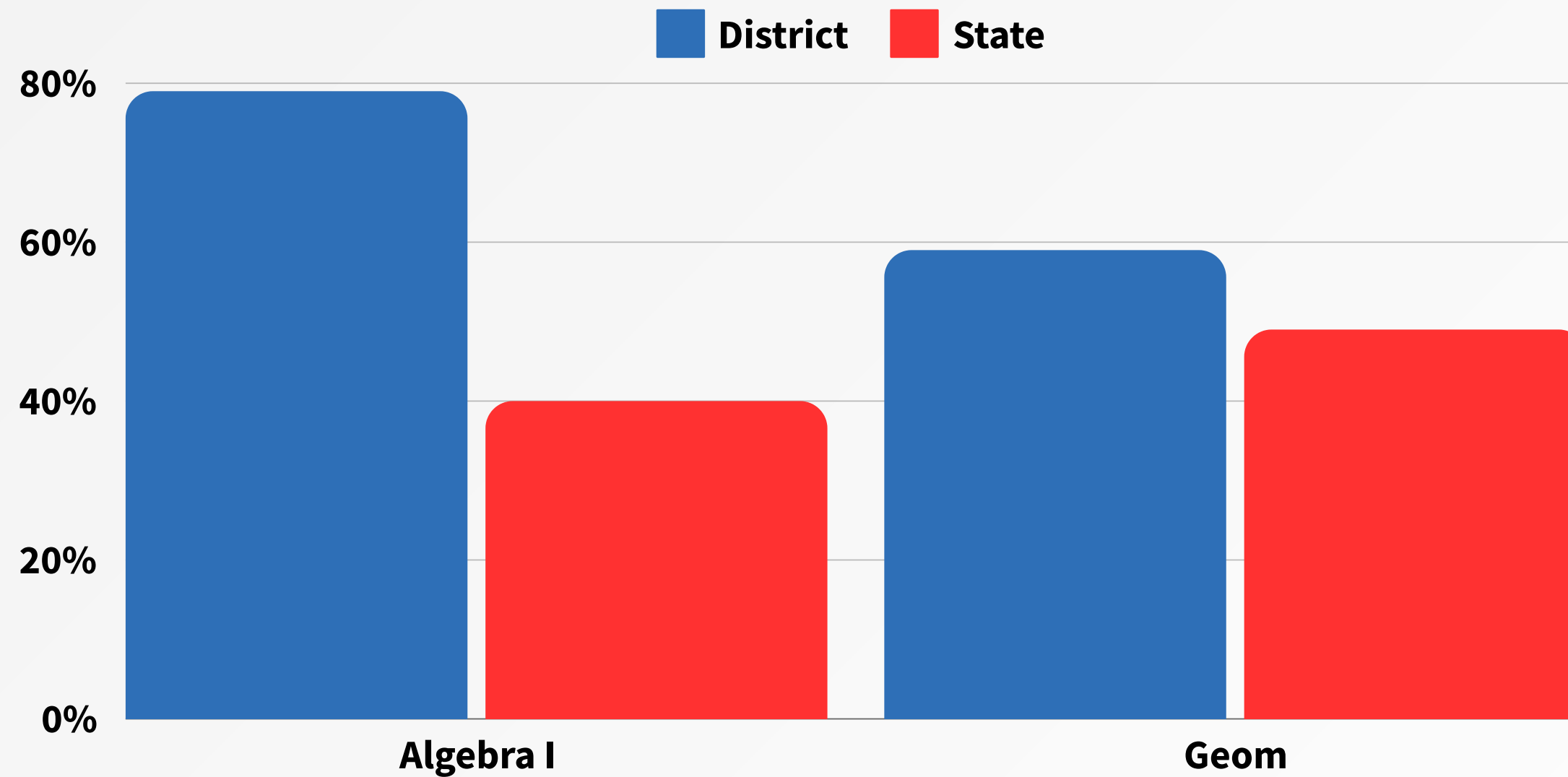


# 2023-2024 State & District Math Passing Comparison

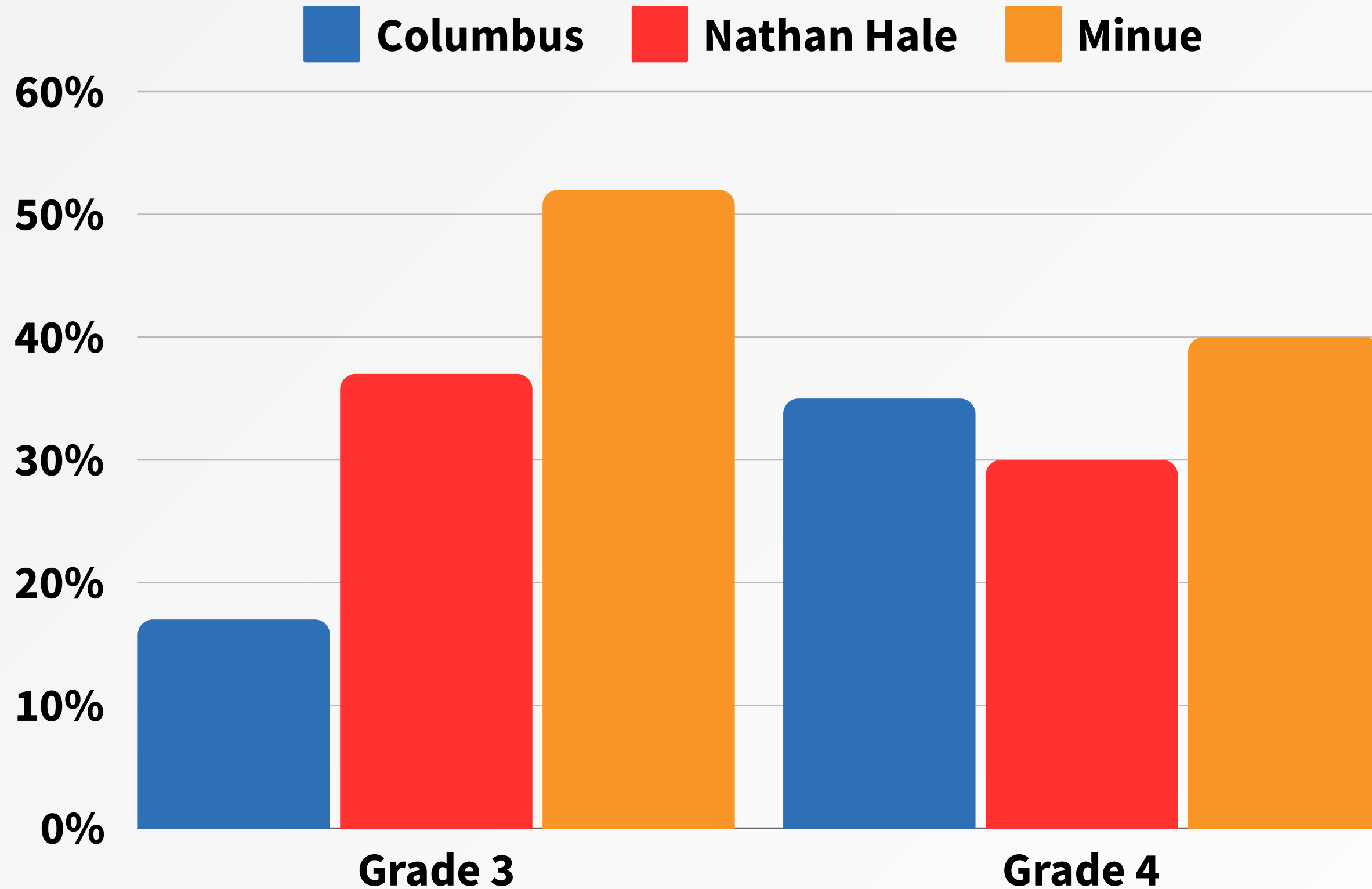

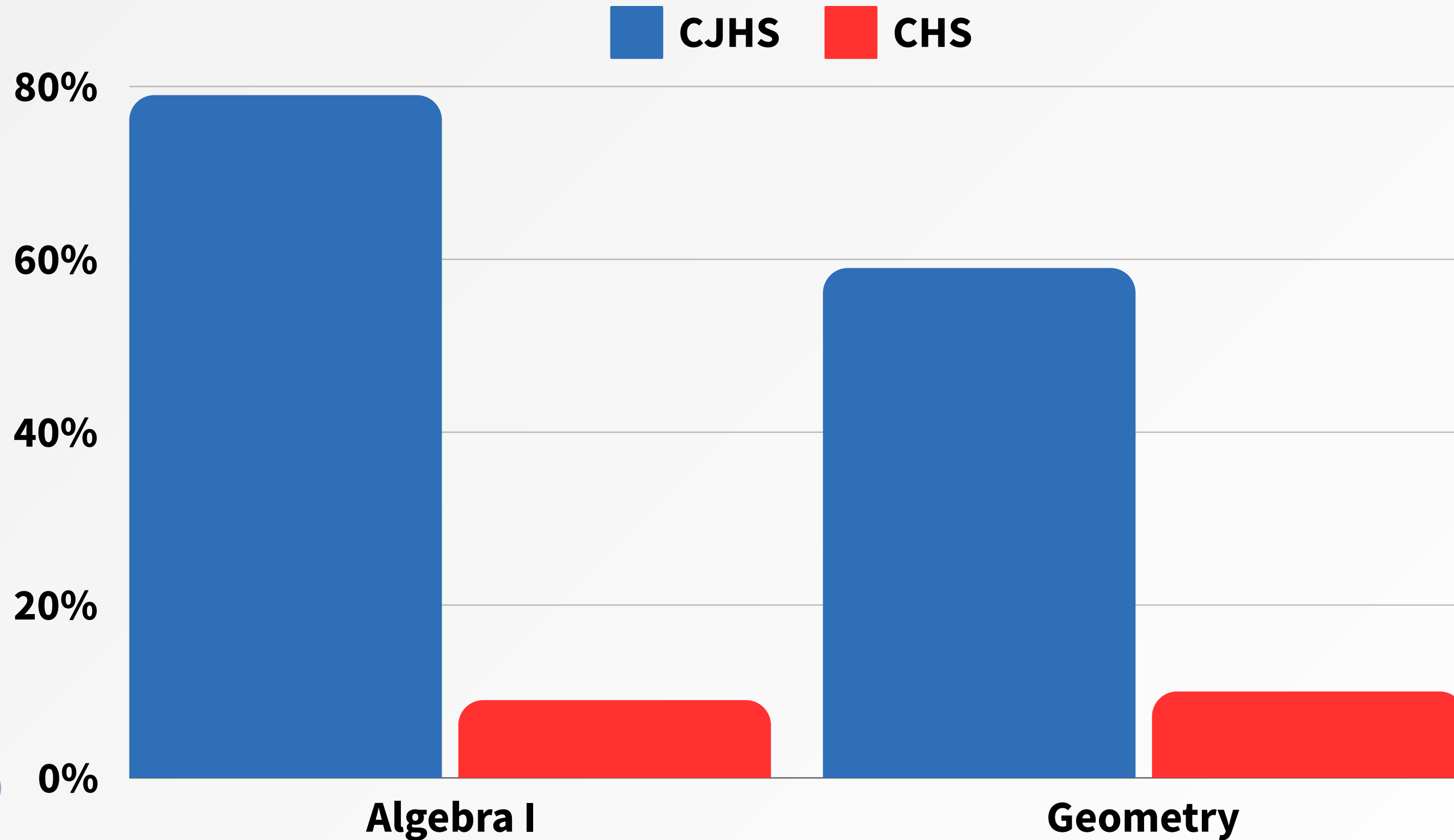

# Carteret Public School's Spring 2024 NJSLA School Grade-Level Comparison Math Proficiency Percentages

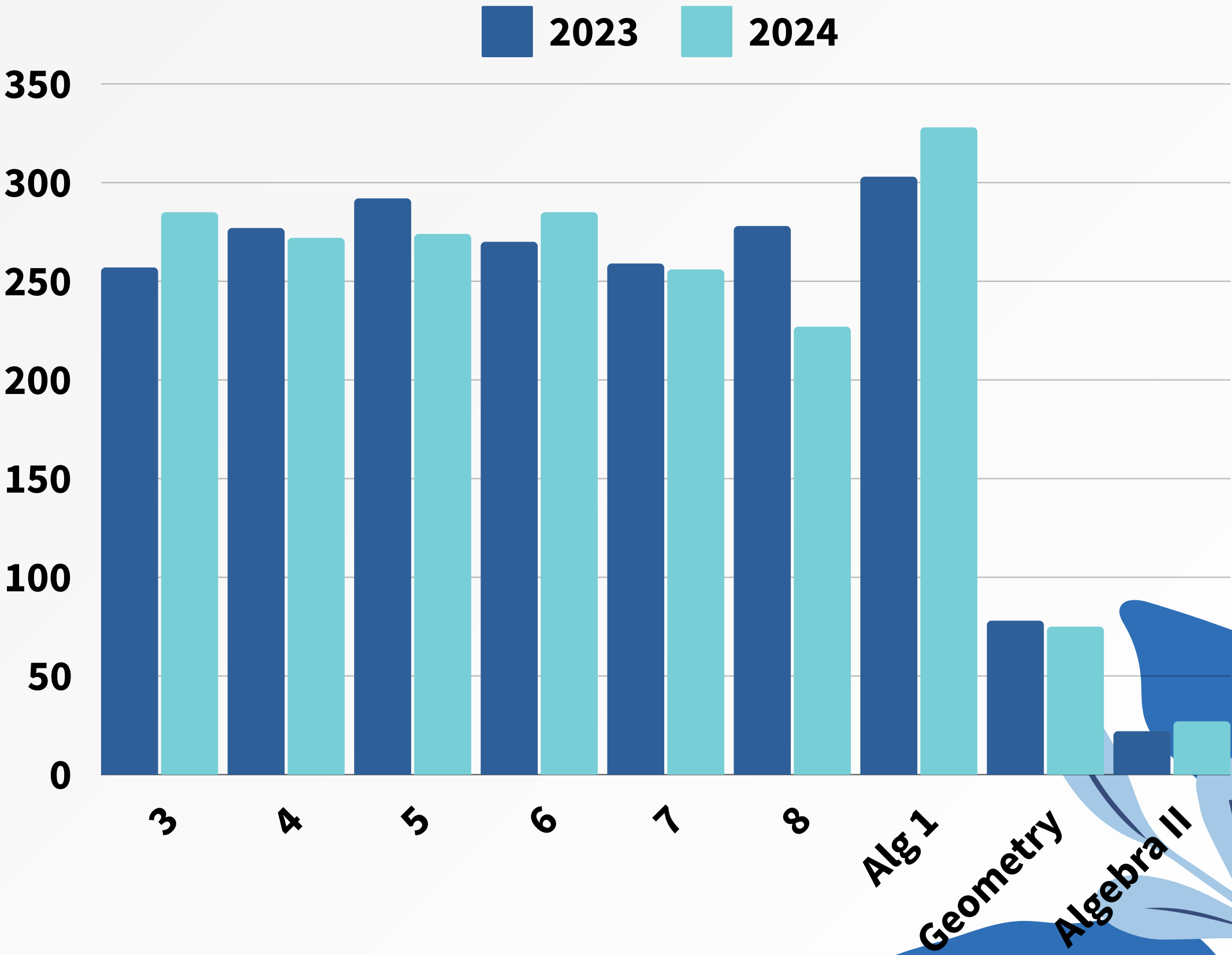

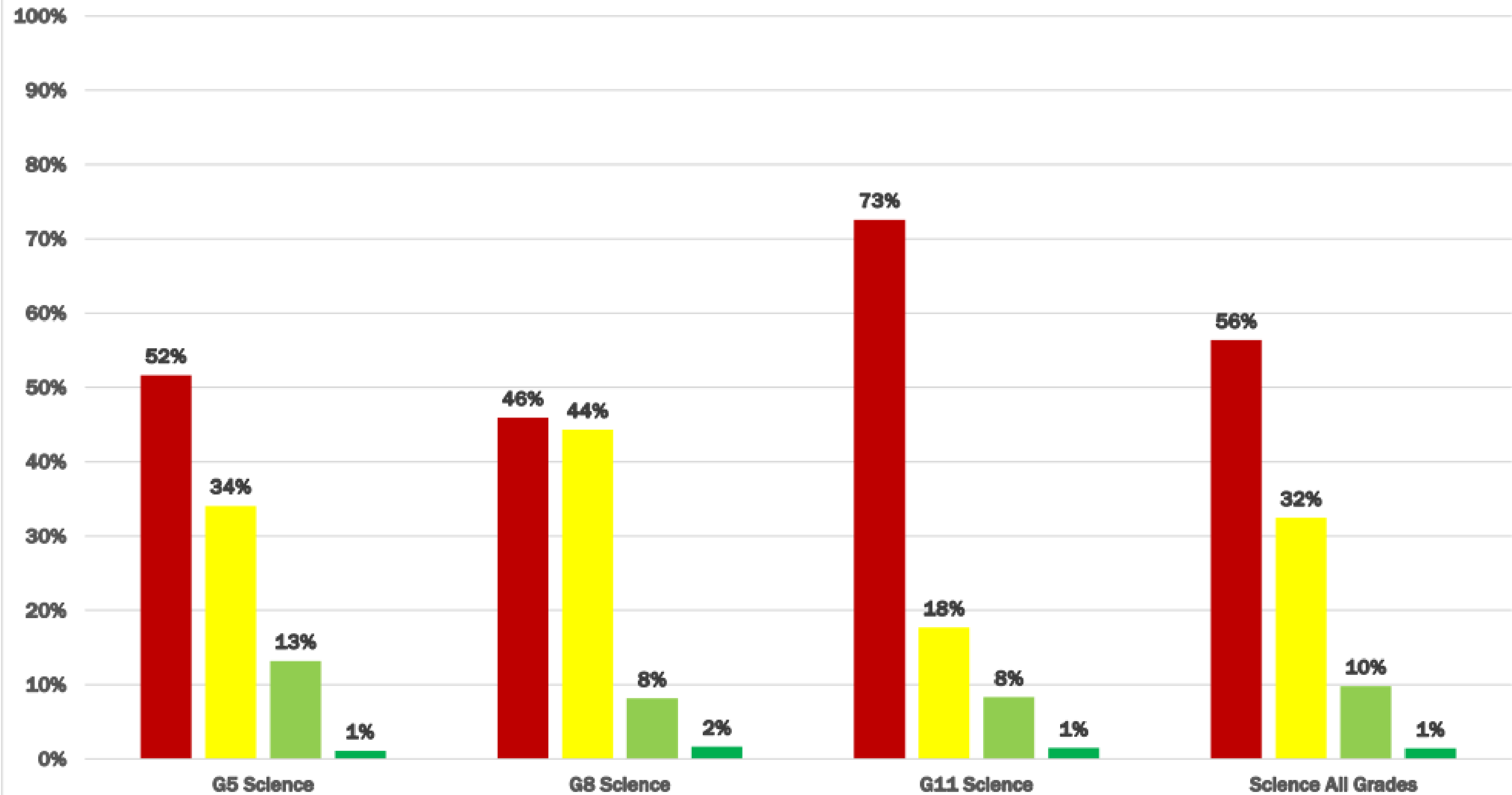

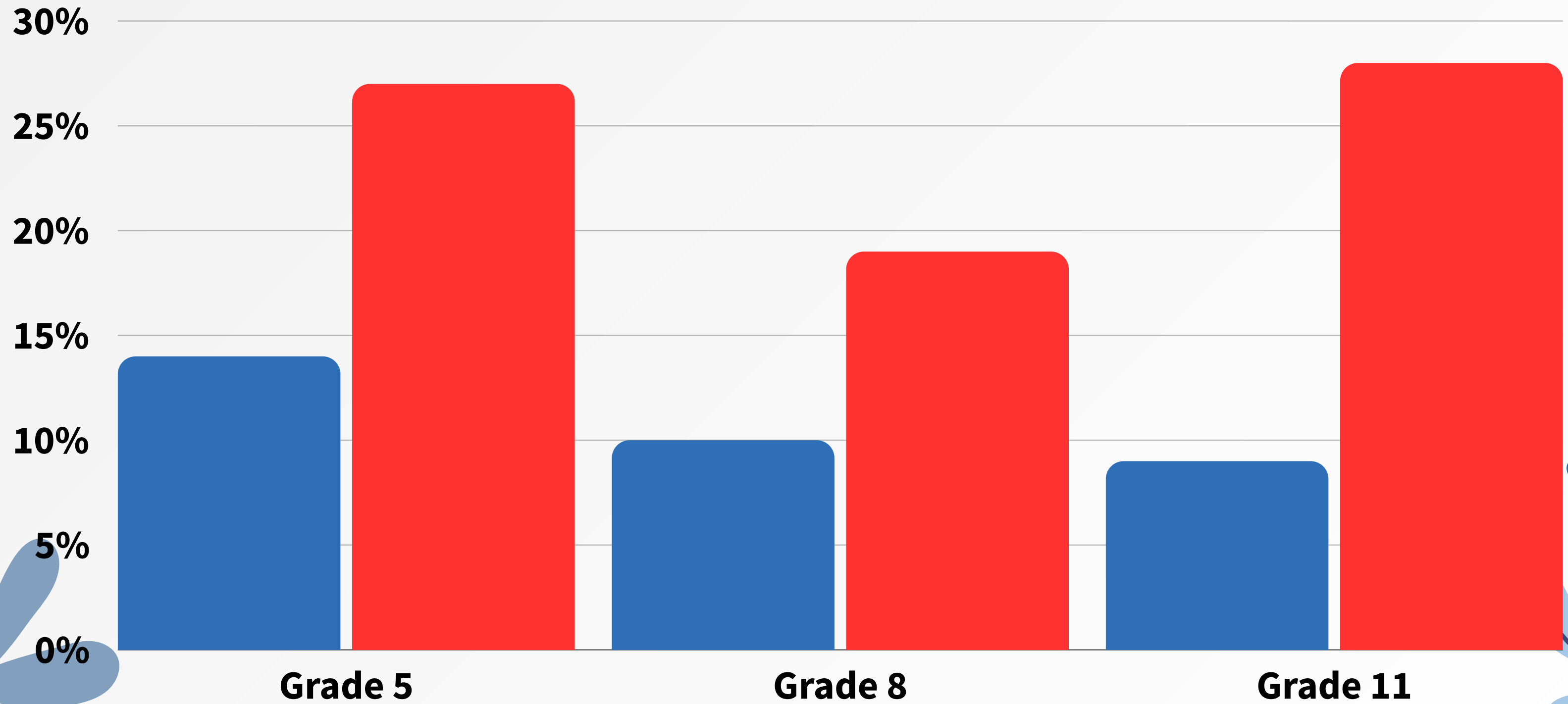
Distribution by Achievement Level (2023-24)

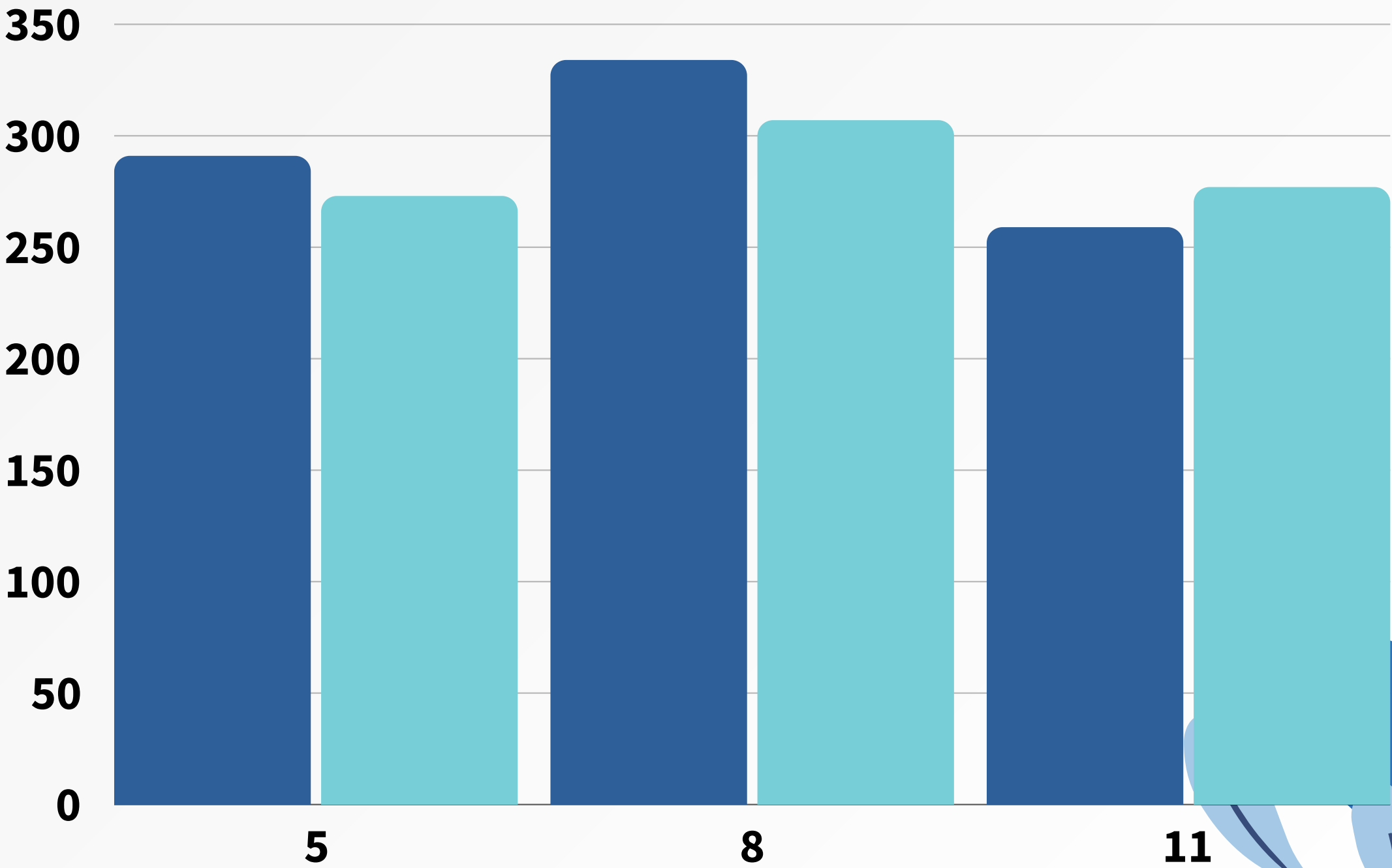

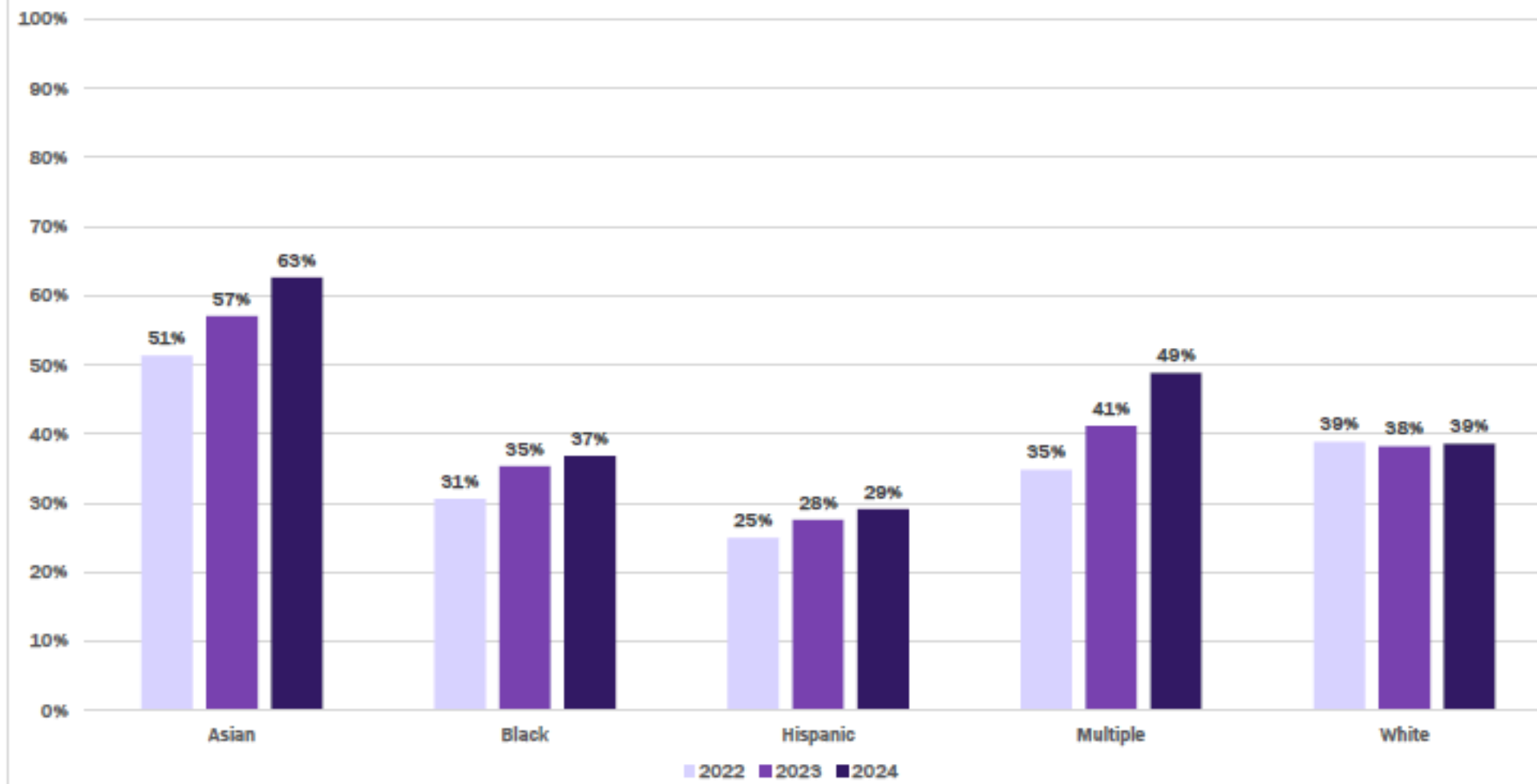

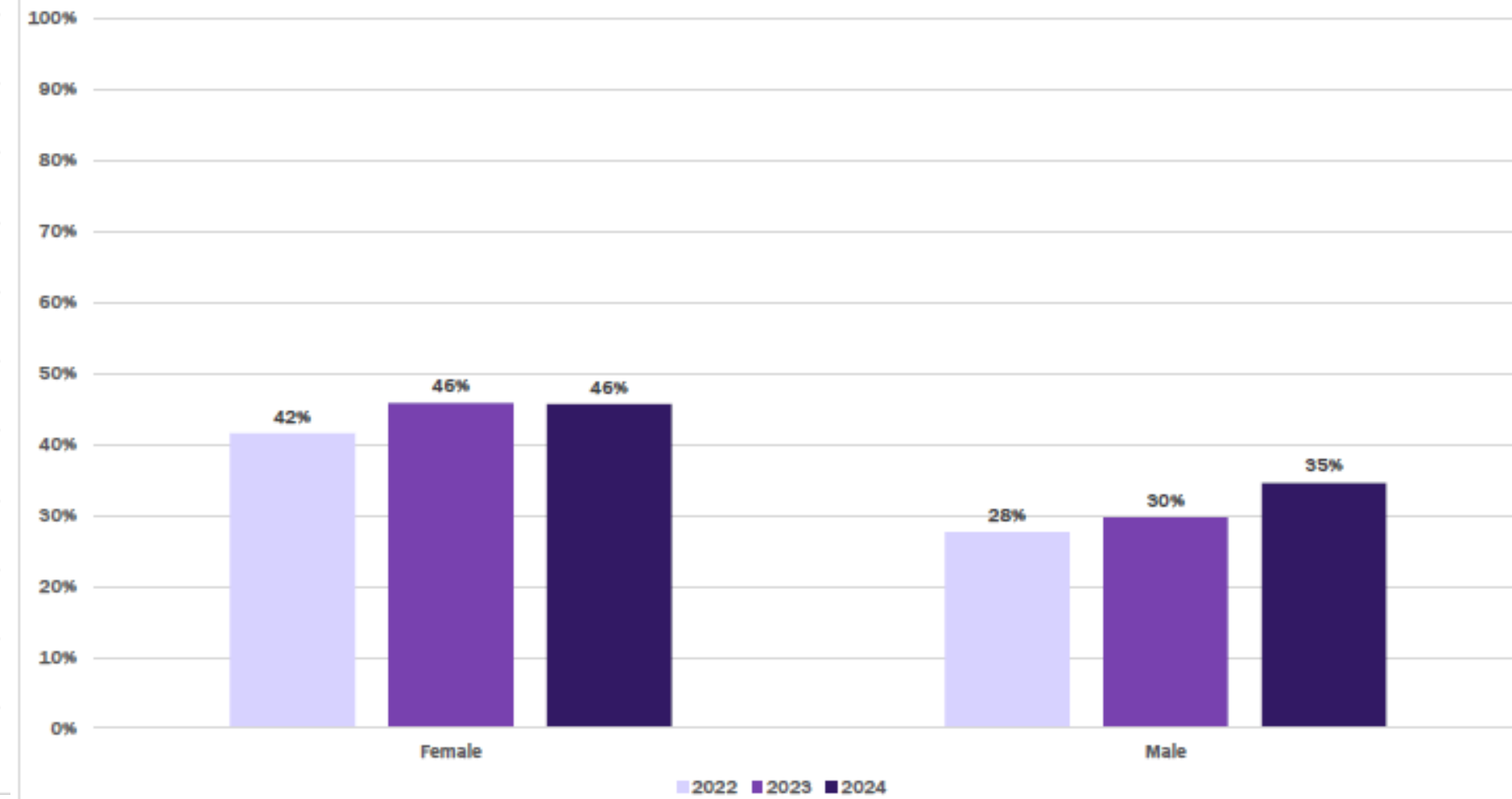
Spring NJSLA by Subgroup Race

% Meeting + Exceeding (All Grades)

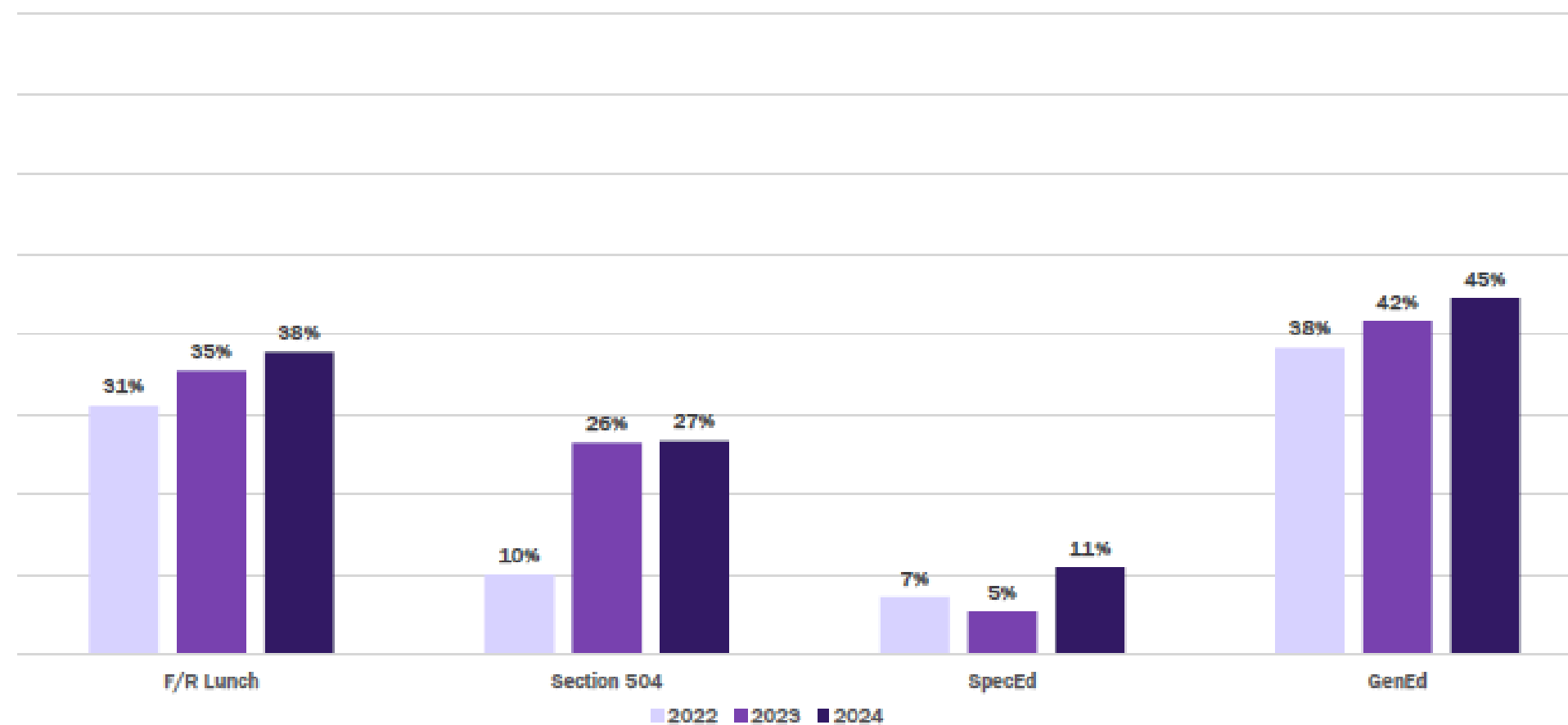


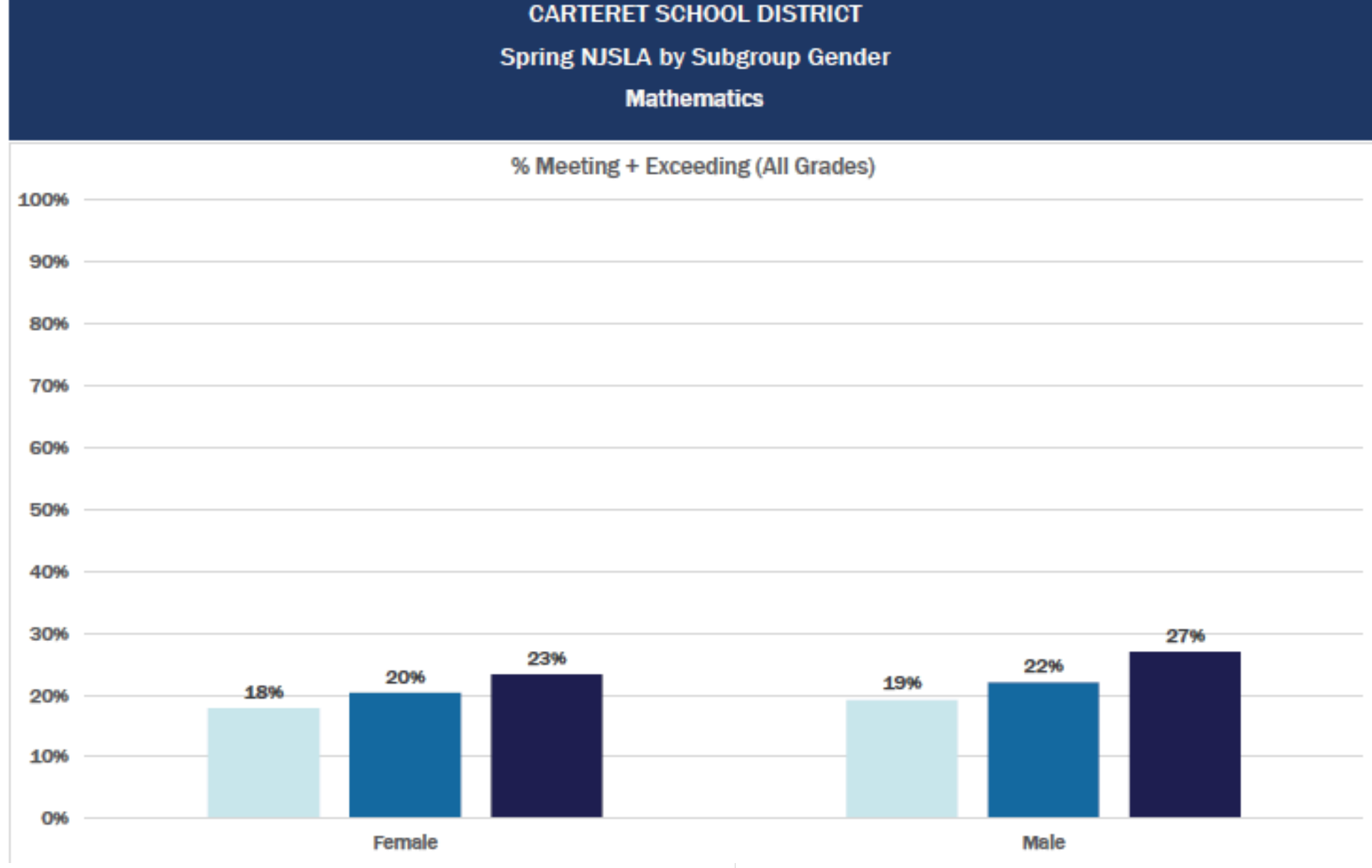
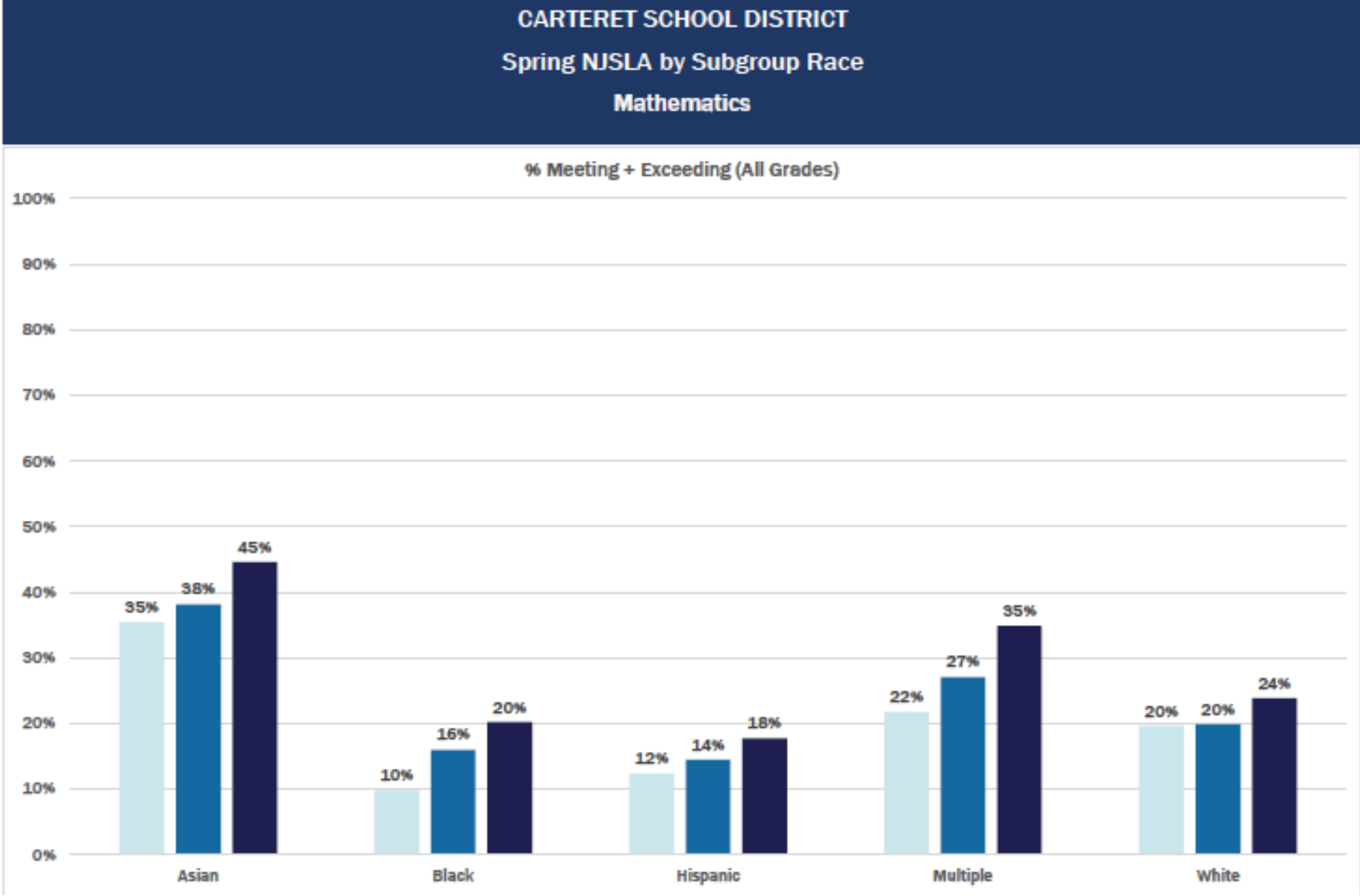
Spring NJSLA by Subgroup Gender

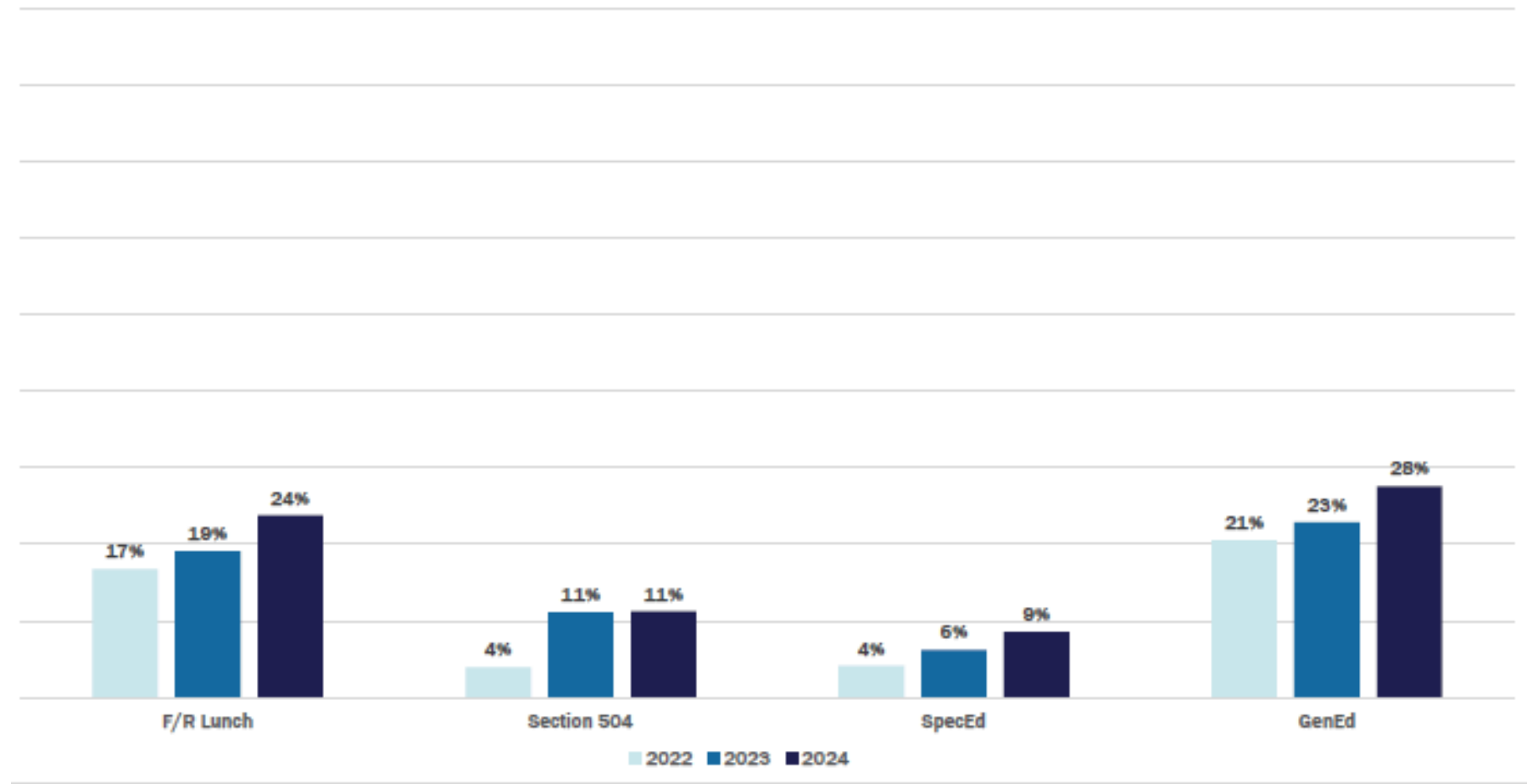

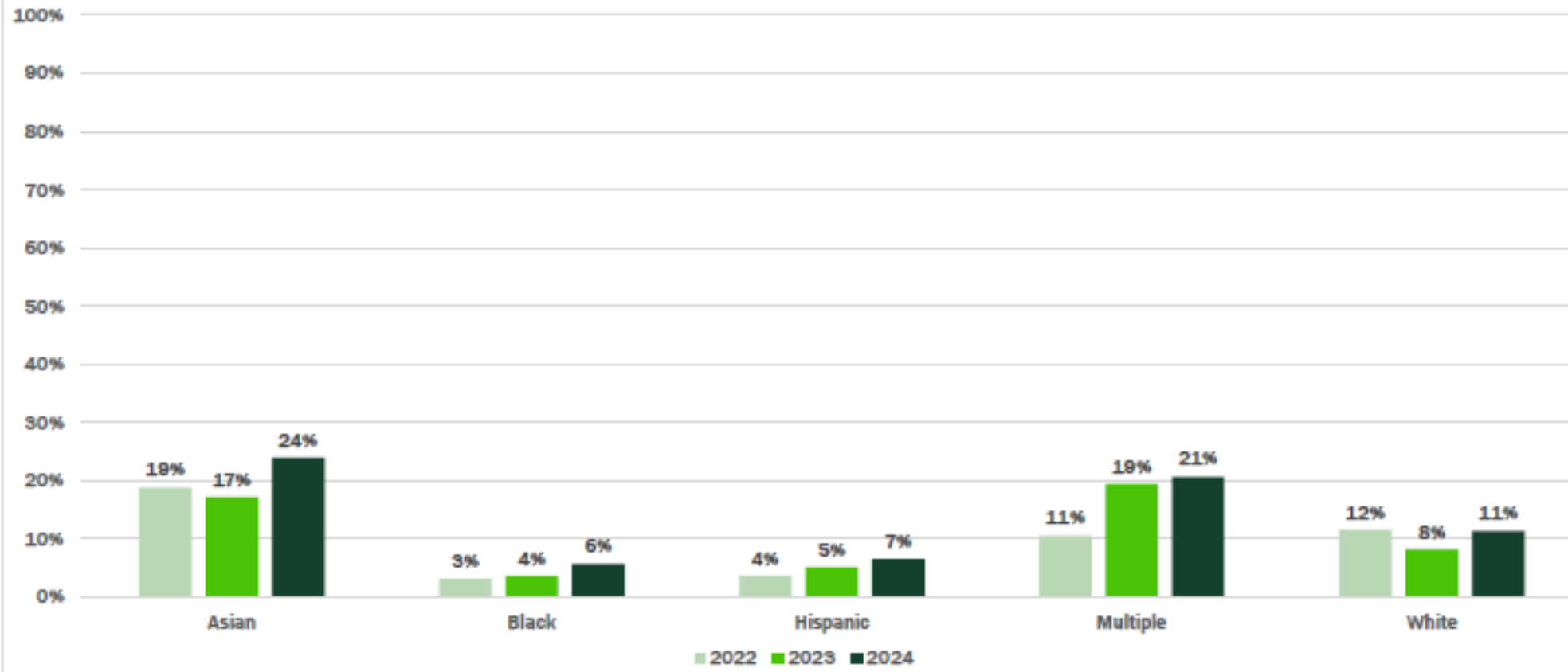

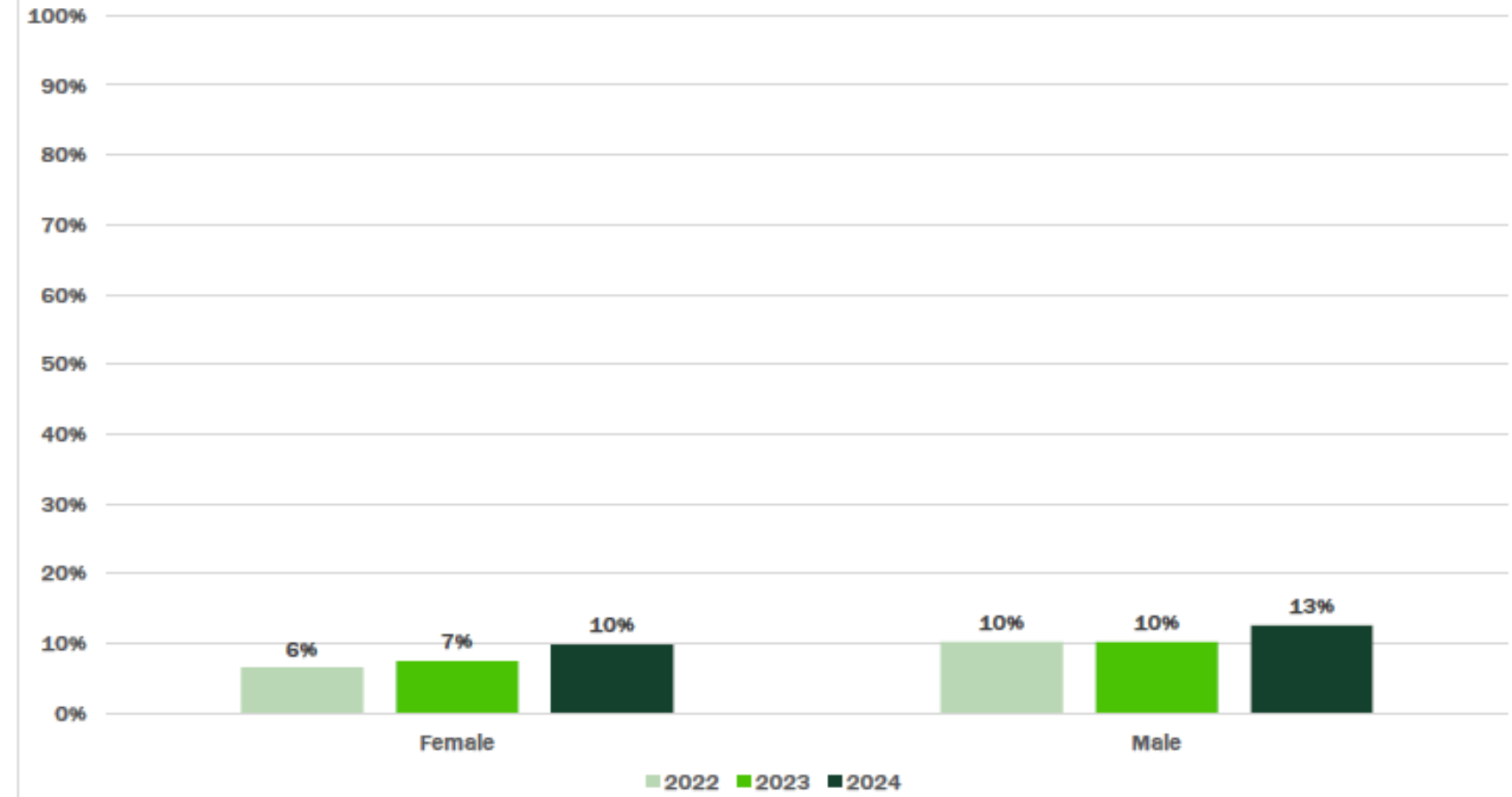

% Proficient + Advanced Proficiency (All Grades)

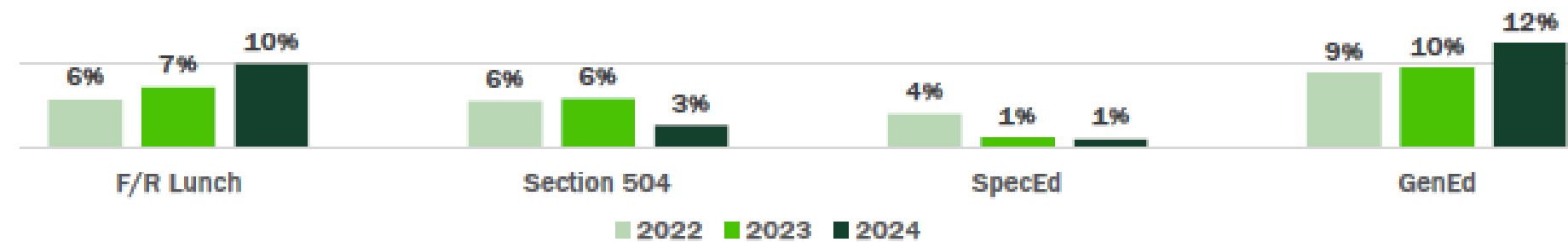

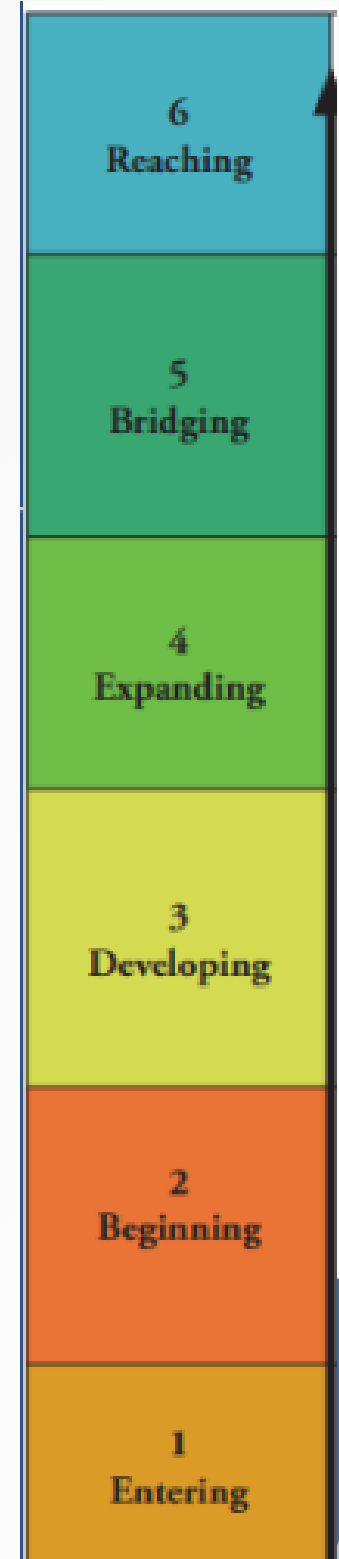
