# ABOUT ME

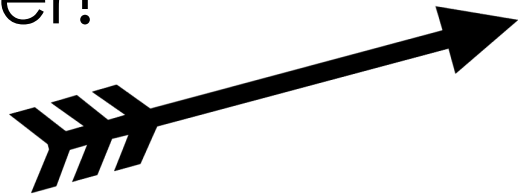
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My name is Mrs. Kirsh and this is my 6th year at Columbus School. This is first year teaching 1st grade!

I love country music, working out and spending time with my family.

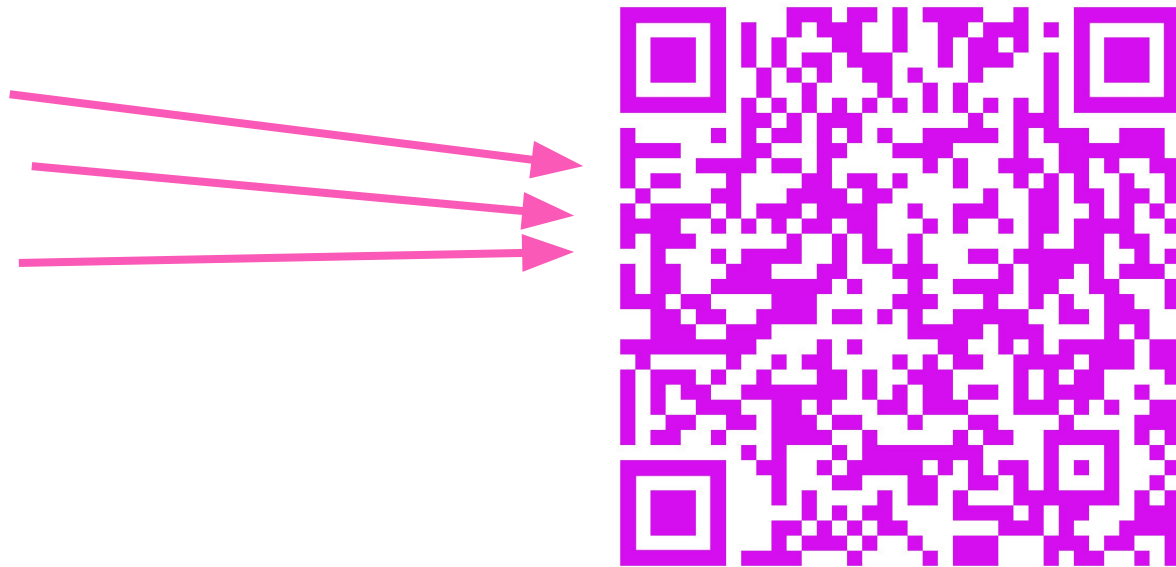

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### Attendance

# ZOOM MEETINGS



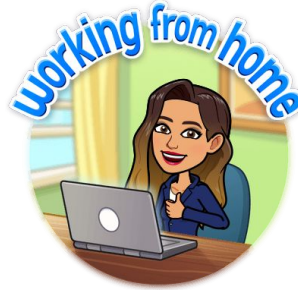
Dress appropriately

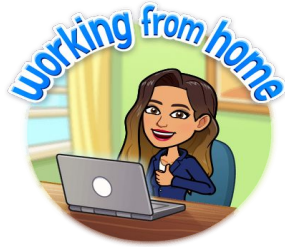


# ONLINE LEARNING
