










Distribution by Achievement Level (All Grades)







Distribution by Achievement Level (All Grades)



Distribution by Achievement Level (All Grades)







Distribution by Achievement Level (All Grades)









NJSLA Math Trend Data 2018, 2019, and 2022





Pandemic Impacts in ELA




Pre and Post Pandemic ELA




Pandemic Impacts in Math



- **100% of 11th grade MD students tested scored at target or advanced in Language Arts, Math and Science indicating their preparedness to become independent adults**




