First Days

The first day of school for students will be Thursday, September 2nd. Staff members will be available to direct parents and students to their grade level designated arrival locations listed below. Students will have an abbreviated session on September 2nd and September 3rd. On both days, students will be dismissed at 1:10 pm.

Masks & Uniforms

The safety of our students is our first priority. Please note that this year students, as well as all staff members, are required by Executive Order 251 to wear a mask for the entirety of the day except while eating. It is essential that your child is wearing a well-fitted and clean mask each day. Please consider this as part of our school uniforms. Our policy for both masks and uniforms can be found on the district's website, as well as in the document section of the Parent Portal and in our updated Parent Information Handbook in the student agenda planners for students in grades two through five. Please use the handbook for your reference when you have a question about school policies and/or procedures. Parent Portal (Emergency Contacts, Required Questionnaires & Lunch Application)

If you haven't already, please be sure to log on to the Parent Portal before the first day of school to find out about your child's classroom placement, to fill out the lunch application (regardless of your status), and to complete and update the parent questionnaires. Completing the questions on the portal assists us in ensuring the safety of your child(ren) as your child will only be released to adults that you designate on the Student Emergency Contact in the Parent Portal. We ask that all adults picking students up always have a valid photo ID; we appreciate your understanding as we work to keep your children safe.

Bus (if eligible)

On the Parent Portal you will also be able to access busing information, if applicable. Bus students must be transported to and from school on their assigned bus and should be met at the stop by an adult. Students will receive tags; please ensure that your child's bus tag is visible and tied securely to the outside of your child's backpack. Bus passes are checked regularly and must remain visible at all times. Masks must be worn on the bus at all times.

Arrival & Dismissal

Students are to arrive at 8:30 am and are dismissed at 2:50 pm. Please see the chart below to determine where your child will be dropped off and picked up each day. Note that all bus students arriving in the morning exit the bus and report to their respective arrival locations.
